GOLD WING RECIPE REVIEW

We have been leading up to Fat Tuesday with a bunch of wonderful Cajun and Creole eats. Hopefully you have had or will have the opportunity to savor one or more of these dishes before you go on your best culinary behavior for Lent. Until then (Ash Wednesday, February 9), let's let the good times roll with dessert and café!

Bon Appetit!

Bananas Foster

2T butter
3T brown sugar
½t cinnamon
¼ banana liqueur
¼c rum
2 bananas sliced lengthwise
2 scoops vanilla ice cream

In a flambé pan or large skillet melt the butter over low heat. Add the sugar and cinnamon and mix well. Put the bananas in the pan and sauté until they begin to turn soft. Pour in the banana liqueur and half of the rum and continue to cook over low heat. Heat the remainder of the rum in a small saucepan until it begins to boil, then quickly pour into the flambé pan and ignite. Distribute and prolong the flame by tipping the pan with a circular motion with one hand and basting the bananas with flame, using a long handled spoon, with the other hand. When the flame dies out, serve two slices of banana to each portion and top each with a scoop of vanilla ice cream. Spoon the sauce remaining in the pan over the ice cream.

Café Brûlot

1 two inch stick of cinnamon
6 whole cloves
¼c thinly slivered orange peel
¼c thinly slivered lemon peel
3 lumps of sugar
½c brandy
2T Curacao
3c hot, strong black coffee

Combine the cinnamon, cloves, orange and lemon peels, and lumps of sugar in a brûlot bowl or chafing dish. Mash together with the back of a ladle. Add the brandy and Curacao and mix well. When the mixture begins to boil, ignite and keep stirring to dissolve the sugar. Add the black coffee very gradually, so as to keep the flame going as long as possible. Serve in brûlot or demitasse cups.
